# Message from the Rector:

Eastertide is a wonderful opportunity to remind ourselves of beliefs which are central to the Christian faith and one of these relates to the words Jesus spoke to his disciples when he shared his 'Last Supper' with them: as bread and wine were given to the disciples, Jesus said "do this in remembrance of me". Over 2000 years later we still say these same words as we re-enact the Last Supper during our services of Holy Communion. Some people refer to this as a great mystery - something we can't fully understand and when children come to church, I invite them especially to join me at the Altar during the Communion Prayers so that they can see more of what's happening, de-mystify a bit - and hopefully help them to feel more of a sense of belonging. You don't have to believe anything to belong to your church: we, like little children, can't fully understand the great mysteries of any religion, but absolutely everyone is welcome, whether you believe, or whether you don't. Church must never be a club for those who think they know and understand everything: the church is for everyone and your church is here for you. You are very warmly invited to come and see for yourself...
